



FLOR DAS TECEDERAS WHITE 2018

Made in our cellar with great care, using native grapes Arinto, Códega do Larinho and Viosinho, this Douro white wine is at once captivating and versatile.

TERROIR

From the heart of the Cima Corgo, this wine is produced from vines planted on schist terraces on the banks of the majestic river Douro as it flows through this, the preeminent sub-region of the appellation.

TASTING NOTES

Varieties Arinto, Viosinho and Códega do Larinho, three native Portuguese grapes that are planted and well regarded in the Douro.

Colour Brilliant pale gold.

Nose Young, with first impressions dominated by tropical and stone fruits. Floral undertones.

Palate Dry, finely balanced acidity, revealing the wine's fruit-driven character. Refreshing finish.

WINEMAKING

Hand-picked. Grapes transported in small boxes. Manual sorting. Total de-stemming followed by gentle pneumatic pressing.

Static clarification. Fermented in temperature-controlled stainless steel vats. Rested on fine lees until January, 2020.

FROM CELLAR TO TABLE

For best results, appreciate at a temperature of 10°C to 12°C. Ideal for pairing with fish and seafood dishes, also a good partner for vegetarian dishes and salads.
